

LaVine Equestrian Barn Rules  
*Alamode Ranch*

1. NO SMOKING. Smoking is not allowed anywhere on the Ranch.
2. A Liability Waiver must be signed by everyone entering the property and prior to handling or riding the horses.
3. Riding is a dangerous sport. HELMETS should be worn at all times. All students under the age of 18 *must* wear a helmet while riding.
4. Children must be attended to at all times. No Running.
5. No bare feet or open-toed shoes are allowed around the barn and horses. This applies to everyone.
6. NEVER tie a horse with a stud chain on.
7. Sweep and clean tie area when done grooming your horse. After riding, always groom your horse, clean your tack, and put everything away neatly where it belongs.
8. Parents, please do not talk on your cell phones while your child is taking his/her lesson. I have found this distracts the child.
9. Please drive under 10 miles an hour from Sierra Hwy on to Ranch and always park in front of the orchard.
10. Dogs must be attended to at all times and cleaned up after.
11. No hand feeding of horses or dogs. No picking up dogs or chasing ranch dogs.
12. Do not feed or pet any animal that is not in La Vine Equestrian care.
13. Always be respectful of others.
14. Children must maintain a "C" average with no "unsatisfactory" marks to participate in equestrian activities.

If a lesson is to be cancelled, 24 hours notice is required or you will be charged for that lesson.

Lesson packages expire 3 months from date of purchase.
